There has been a surge in the AQI levels in the last two days (as per attached AQI data from SAFAR-Air App) and immediate actions and preventive measures need to be taken to ensure the situation does not worsen. Based on the High Court Of Judicature At Bombay Civil Appellate Jurisdiction Suo Moto Public Interest Litigation No. 3 of 2023 dated 10 November 2023 and the implementation of Graded Response Action Plan (GRAP) published by the Maharashtra Pollution Control Board (MPCB) with reference to the letter dated 13 October 2023, the following measures will be implemented till 19 November 2023. Based on the order published by PCMC dated 07/11/2023 and 09/11/2023, the Task Force shall monitor the implementation of the following at the city level.

1. Stop construction activities in the city till further notice
2. Increase frequency of mechanised cleaning of roads, sprinkling of water on roads etc.

After November 19, 2023, the decision to ease or maintain current measures will be contingent upon the Air Quality Index (AQI) levels.
