Maharashtra Stamp Act. No.Mudrank-2023/C.R.No.342/M-1(Policy).- Whereas, the Government of Maharashtra *vide* Government Order, Revenue and Forests Department, No. Mudrank-2023/C.R.No.342 /M-1(Policy), dated the 7th December 2023 (hereinafter referred to as "the said Order") issued in exercise of the powers conferred by clause (a) of section 9 of the Maharashtra Stamp Act (LX of 1958), being satisfied that it is necessary so to do in the public interest, decided to introduce the Maharashtra Stamp Duty Amnesty Scheme-2023 (hereinafter referred to as 'the said Amnesty Scheme-2023') in order to remit or reduce stamp duty and the penalty on the instrument, chargeable under the provision of the 'the said Act', to be implemented in two phases, the first phase shall be from the 1st December 2023 till the 31st January 2024 and the second phase shall be from the 1st February 2024 till the 31st March 2024 subject to the conditions specified therein;

And whereas, the Government of Maharashtra considers it expedient to amend the said Order so as to extend the period of first phase from the1st December 2023 till the 29th February 2024 and the second phase from the 1st March 2024 till the 31st March 2024 for the said Amnesty Scheme-2023;

Now, therefore, in exercise of the powers conferred by clause (a) of section 9 of the Maharashtra Stamp Act (LX of 1958), and of all other powers enabling it in this behalf, the Government of Maharashtra hereby amends the said Order, as follows, namely:-

In the said Order-

- (a) for the words, figures and letters "31st January 2024" the words "29th February 2024" shall be substituted.
- (b) for the words, figures and letters "1st February 2024" the words "1st March 2024" shall be substituted.
